

# Getting Started Using SOAS Computers

#### **Your Computer Account**

#### **Username:**

<the 6-digit number on your student ID> <for Language students L or F should precede the 5-digit number>

**Password (temporary):** <*your date of birth>* (Date format: **dd-Mmm-yy** e.g. **09-Aug-90**. The first letter of the month is in uppercase). You should change your password as soon as possible.



## Changing your password

Once you have logged onto the network, you can use the following link

http://inet.soas.ac.uk/change-password to change your password. You will be asked to set up some questions so that you can log in when you forget your password. Password should be 8 characters or more, use a combination of uppercase, lowercase and numbers and avoid symbols such as, ",.@:;' etc.

### E-mail

Your student ID is also your email address (e.g. **123456@soas.ac.uk**). You can access your email at <u>http://mail.soas.ac.uk</u>.

Logging in to SOAS PCs or applications requires a username, your six-digit code student number (for Language students this is preceded by the letter L) or e-mail address, however, the password is the same.




## **Internet and Wi-Fi**

Internet access is available on all PCs. You can connect your laptop and mobile devices using the **Eduroam Wi-Fi network**. Use your SOAS login details to connect (e-mail address as your username e.g. <u>123456@soas.ac.uk</u> and password). Once you have used the wireless network at SOAS, you can use it at other academic institutions that use the Eduroam network.

## Printing

SOAS operates a 'follow me' printing system, which means that you can log onto any printer on the campus and Print your documents. Upon enrolment, all SOAS students are given credit in their accounts.

Undergraduates receive £7.50, equivalent to 150 black and white A4 sheets.

Postgraduates receive £12.50

Research students receive £20.

Once you have used your credits, you can top up your account using one of the top up stations (outside the Library, on Level E in the Library, or in the lower level of SHNB).

It is important that you should top up to the required amount, (any remaining balance is not refundable) when your course ends.
