With apologies this is a fairly simple but multi-faceted request.

I have received a request from the Archivist, Jenny Ng, of the Methodist Church in Singapore, requesting digital copy of the SPCK title "From Mission to Church", published in 1946 (without copyright notice) in Great Britain, with copy to be made from an original in SOAS, University of London library.

I write to request permission to make the copy from the original in the SOAS, University of London. If permitted and at your instruction, I can supply either a paper off-print or digital version, which can be provisioned in PDF, JPG or TIF.

SOAS, at no cost to SPCK, will happily supply you with copies of all digital image files (TIFF v.6, uncompressed, RGB, colour/24-bit page images).

I write further to request permission to place a digital copy in the forthcoming SOAS Digital Library. Such copy, I request, would be available under a Creative Commons license (Attribution/Non-Commercial/Share-Alike OR Attribution/Non-Commercial/No-Derivatives).

We will credit the Society for Promoting Christian Knowledge in bibliographic records, in online display and link to the web page of your choice for additional information about the Society. We are capable of monitoring use and providing statistical information on use of the digital copy.

The paper copy in our collections appears to have entered the Stoke Newington Public Library in 1947, where it was never used. It was then transferred to the Greenwich Public Library at a date uncertain, where it was used only once before it was transferred to SOAS, University of London in 1991. Since coming to SOAS, the title has had no recorded use.
